Ways to help your children are:

- Listening to your child read regularly and talking about the book, please use the question prompts from Parents evening and the bookmarks
- Ensuring they complete their English and Maths homework and return their books by Wednesday. Online homework will run from Monday to Thursday each week
- Encouraging them to practice their weekly spellings
- Practising times-table and division facts with your child - particularly developing speed
- Checking they have instant recall of place value of 4-digit numbers
- Aim for punctuality and 100% attendance
