Your child's topics this term will be:

- Weather
- People who help us

During this term, your child will learn about:

- Experiments: What happens with the weather?
- Colour mixing.
- Team games and Gymnastics.
- Listening to and retelling stories.
 Drama relating to stories.
- Learning the names and roles of people who help us.
- Festivals/Celebrations Chinese New Year, Pancake Day, Mother's Day and Easter.

Science investigations:

Your child will be taking part in lots of investigations and experiments during our Weather topic. This will help them to understand the changes to the Weather and how this happens.

Role play:

During our topic of People who help us your child will take on the role of many different things: police officer, vet etc, this will help them to understand the role in more detail.

The children will concentrate on:

- Counting to 20 forwards and backwards. One more and one less.
- Ordering by size, weight and capacity.
- Listening to and retelling a range of stories
- Working together in a team.
- Writing CVC words (eg, cat) and beginning to write full sentences, remembering capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. Reading and writing the tricky words eg, am, and, the.

Ways to help your child are:

- By talking to them about the work we are doing at school.
- Observing the environment around you: changes in the weather, the different jobs people have etc.
- Aim for punctuality and 100% attendance.
