Why we are asking for your views

In the coming years new housing developments in Micklefield village will increase the need for additional primary school places. Your views will help the Council decide whether or not to increase places at Micklefield Church of England (C of E) Primary School so it's important that you share your thoughts with us.

Please read this leaflet and join the conversation at one of our community drop-in sessions and by responding to our on-line survey.

Impact of additional homes in the village

There are currently two housing developments with planning permission for around 340 homes and plans for further housing which may be built in the future. Based on this we believe that we will need up to 10 additional school places in each year group. We know that historically families in the village have sent their children to Micklefield C of E Primary School and primaries in Garforth. Although this may continue in future years, we want to increase places at Micklefield C of E Primary School so that we can offer families more local places.

The changes we want to make

Leeds City Council wants to make Micklefield C of E Primary School bigger so that it can admit an additional 10 children into its reception class, increasing it from 20 places to places 30 from September 2021.

Community Drop-in sessions

We are holding community drop-in sessions so that local residents, parents/carers and anyone else can attend to find out more, ask questions and share views.
