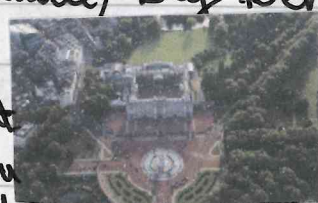
Dear Diary
