Met Office - Yellow Weather Warning

Dear Parents/Carers,

The Met Office states that over the next few days we due to have some particularly bad weather:

Today:

A very cold start with severe frost, ice and areas of freezing fog. The fog should steadily clear allowing some brighter spells for a time. However, skies will cloud over with sleet and snow arriving in the southwest by evening. Maximum temperature 3 °C.

Tonight:

Becoming cloudy overnight with outbreaks of snow continuing for most places, although steadily easing. Another cold night with frost and ice. Minimum temperature -1 °C.

School Advice:

As you know the safety of our children, parents and staff is our greatest priority therefore please note the plan for tomorrow:

Friday 1st February 2019 – Due to forecast of freezing conditions mixed with snow overnight we will keep registers open until 10:00 am on this day to give you the opportunity to make the safest decision to get into school. Unless you hear from us (website or message via our school app) school, will remain open as usual, from 8:40, however if you feel it is safer to travel after the main bulk of traffic this option is open to you. On this occasion (health and safety reasons) your child's attendance will not be affected if they arrive after 8:55 am.

Once again I must reiterate that unless you receive direct information from the school we will be open as normal.
