Important Reminder

Please be very aware that we have a child in school who has a nut allergy. Nuts and peanuts can cause allergic reactions, which are sometimes severe. A severe reaction to nuts is called anaphylaxis and can be life threatening. Avoiding foods that contain nuts will prevent an allergic reaction.

As a consequence of this we are asking all parents to ensure that nuts or nut based products (i.e. chocolate spread, peanut butter and cereal bars) are <u>NOT</u> sent into school in lunch boxes.
