Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March - World Book Day. Information will follow shortly.

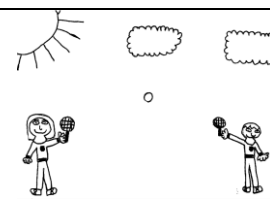
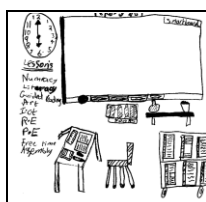
## After School Clubs for Spring 2 Half Term

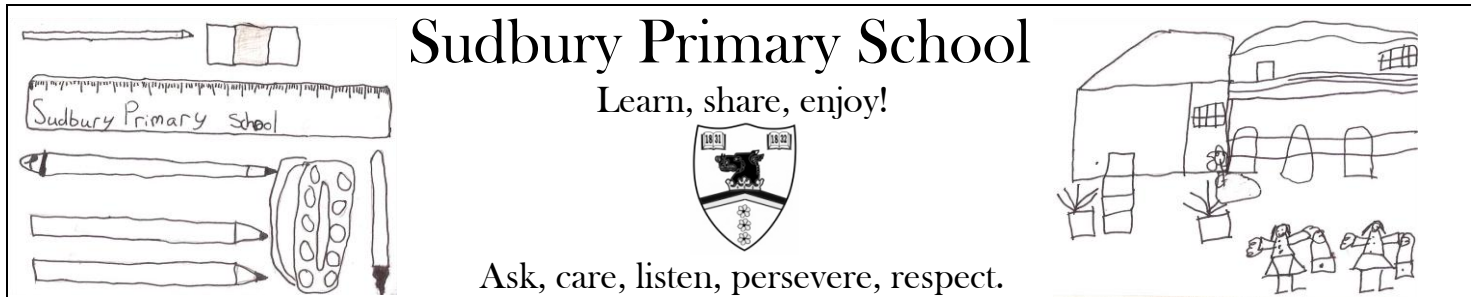

Thank you to everyone who came to the FOSS AGM! We achieved a lot in the 2017/18 academic year and have even bigger plans for this academic year.

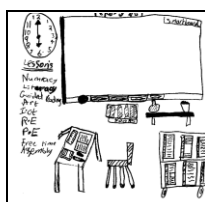
