Prime Areas

In Communication and Language, the children have been speaking about the roles of people who help us and how we can contact them if we need to and why.

In Expressive Arts and Design the children have been using their boxes to reiterate the 3D shapes learnt and built their own creation!

In Understanding the World the children have been talking about friendship groups and what it means to be a good friend.

Specific Areas

In Literacy this week the children have been learning all about real life heroes such as police, fire fighters and doctors etc. We have talked about their job roles and qualities needed for this and the children have written all about it. In Phonics, the children have been re-capping the sounds they have learnt so far and learning new phase 3 sounds. The new sounds they have learnt are:

ai, ee, igh, oa

In Maths, the children have been learning about 3D shapes. They have used the boxes that they bought in to make their own models whilst talking about the properties of the shape.
