#### **PARKING at PICK UP TIME (I'm leaving this in again this week as clearly some people haven't read it. If someone else is picking your child up please let them know our parking etiquette)**

**Please DO NOT park on grass verges, the turning circle or on the double yellow lines in the road. Please treat the turning circle as 1 way only with no parking allowed.**

Double parking is allowed in the area next to the school field gate, but please use all the parking spaces in that area first. These slots are best used by those who have children in both the infants and juniors.

If you cannot find a space drive out and come back after 5 minutes when chances are a slot will have become available. Teachers will always hold on to your child if you are a few minutes late. We understand that sometimes parents get delayed,
