PLEASE NOTE - NUT ALLERGY

Please be very aware that we have some children in school who have a nut allergy. Nuts and peanuts can cause allergic reactions, which are sometimes severe. A severe reaction to nuts is called anaphylaxis and can be life threatening. Symptoms often start quickly, within an hour of coming into contact with a nut, and sometimes within minutes. Avoiding foods that contain nuts will prevent an allergic reaction. As a consequence of this we have asked all parents to ensure that nuts or nut based products (i.e. chocolate spread, peanut butter and cereal bars) are not sent into school in lunch boxes.

SAFEGUARDING INCIDENTS - Stranger Danger

There have been a number of safeguarding incidents in the Bradford area this past week. Children have been approached by adults on their way to school and the police have been made aware of a man acting suspiciously outside the school gates of two primary schools. Please can you make sure you know where your children are at all times and remind them of the dangers of talking to strangers.

This presents a hazard as not only does it prevent residents from driving away from their property, it also means that emergency vehicles are unable to access the back of Steadman Terrace. There will also be somebody available from Facilities Management to help any parents who are having problems setting up Parent Pay.


We are hoping to start cooking sessions for parents in the Summer term. During this session there will be an opportunity for parents to sign up.
