HOW TO GET THE APP AND GET STARTED


Please visit the App Store (iPhone) or Play Store (Android) and search School Jotter. The photos below relate to an iPhone but Androids are very similar. The app will look like the below:



Simply click GET and install (the app is free). Once downloaded it will save to your phone and appear as the icon. You will then need to select Boxgrove Primary School as your chosen school.

You will then be given a few options to choose from. We would encourage you to turn notifications on. Choose *Allow* and *Notify Me*. You can choose to turn off certain year groups later.

How to turn Push notifications off and on: From the Dashboard, click the three lines in the top left hand corner. Click on settings. You will see the first screen to the right. Choose either News or Alerts by clicking the >. To only receive notifications for your child/children's year group(s), simple swipe the white circle to the left. This will turn off notifications for that group. To turn back on, simply swipe to the right.
