Proposed Road Closure

As you may all be aware from the signs on Bradlegh Road, there is a proposed road closure in place from Tuesday 5th Feb for 5 days. This is for re-surfacing of the road from the start of Bradlegh Rd (near Alexandra Nursing Home) to the entrance of the Cottage Hospital. We have been advised by the highways department at St Helens Council to direct vehicles to use the other access road to Bradlegh Rd near Aldi. As the road outside school will be closed we advise parents/carers to park responsibly away from the ongoing roadworks and to be respectful of local residents. Please park as far away from school as possible and make use of the footpaths to access school.
