



## Local Offer for Anderton Park Primary School

At Anderton Park Primary School we will do all we can to support your child.

What can I expect at school if my child has Special Needs?

### A Partnership Approach

- We will work with you to identify the needs of your child and put into place the correct support including family support if you need it.
- Sometimes we may ask your permission to involve other qualified agencies.
- Your views and your child's views will be taken into account. You will be invited into school to share your views.
- Together we will agree targets and help with strategies to support your child at home.
- If your child has medical needs that are of concern we will complete a medical care plan if necessary in conjunction with our own school nurse ( Salma Booth).
- The school nurse will liaise with school (Prem Narrayn)

### Appropriate and Effective Teaching and Learning

- There will be good teaching, well differentiated lessons and extra support for some children when needed.
- A baseline assessment will be completed by the teacher and a challenging target set for the end of the year.
- A range of resources will be available in all learning areas to support the learning of children who are working at different levels.
- Where necessary, resources will be available to support children who have significant social or communication needs.
- School staff will receive appropriate training so that they have the knowledge to support children's needs.
- The school will provide support for children with managing their own behaviour and /or to build up skills and confidence in dealing with social situations.
- We will try to make sure that children with additional needs are able to fully participate in the life of the school.

### Open and Honest Communication

- We have a member of staff – the Inclusion Leader/SENCO Mrs Mayne who will explain everything to you and make sure that you understand.
- Mrs Mayne will ensure all necessary staff are aware of your child's needs.
- Your child's progress will be reviewed regularly and these will include parents' evenings, teacher meetings and on occasions meetings with Mrs Mayne.
- On occasion you may be invited to come into school and share your views. Your child will also be able to share their views at this meeting.
- If you feel that your child needs extra support we will discuss this with you.
