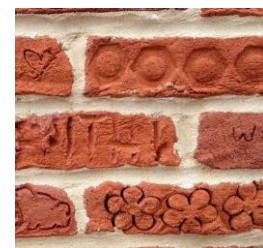
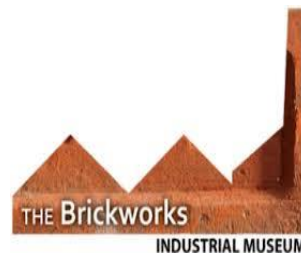
**KS1 Trip to Bursledon Brickworks Industrial Museum**

**Year 2 - Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> March**

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am thrilled to tell you that we have confirmed our next school trip to Bursledon Brickworks Industrial Museum. The workshops will support the learning for our topic of 'Structures' brilliantly!!



The outline of the day is as follows:

- Explore the materials that houses could be made with.
- Tour the museum, looking closely at how buildings (and the machinery they used) have changed in the last 100 years.
- Make a brick by hand using the traditional method, followed by making a mini wall.
- Discuss the properties of a brick.
- Explore different materials and make a brick (to be fired in the kiln).
- Due to the size of the museum, we will be going in year groups on separate days. The dates are as follows:
- Year 2 - Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2019 (with **Mrs Cobb** and Miss Cox)
- Year 1 – Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2019 (with **Mrs Nyland** and Miss Cambridge)

It is advised that your child should come to school wearing **comfortable, closed shoes** and **warm 'messy' clothes** (that you don't mind getting dirty). We don't expect them to wear school uniform for this trip.

Your child's packed lunch can be provided (to replace their hot school dinner). Please indicate on the attached permission form which option you require. Of course, you are more than welcome to provide their own lunch.

To cover the cost of the trip which includes a morning and afternoon workshop as well as coach travel we will be asking for **£12.40** per child. This is a voluntary contribution, however, if we do not receive enough contributions we will not be able to go ahead with this visit. We receive funding for any families eligible for Pupil Premium, so the cost for these pupils will be paid for from this funding.
