



## Year 6 visit to Heatree Activity Centre

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our next enquiry, 'Who were the greater engineers - The Victorians or The Ancient Britons' we are planning an exciting visit to Heatree Activity Centre. The children will be taking part in a prehistory day, travelling back in time to both a Stone Age and a Bronze Age settlement. They will have opportunities to participate in a range of daily tasks, such as spear whittling, food preparation and pottery, and will look at how life changed throughout the prehistoric period.

The trip will take place on ~~Monday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2019~~, rescheduled for **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2019**. We will travel by coach and leave school at 9:00AM, returning to school at approximately 3:20PM.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £15.00. If we do not receive enough contributions, the trip may not be able to take place.

The children will not need to wear school uniform, but will need to wear suitable warm clothing and footwear for outdoor work, and bring a waterproof coat. Please note the day will largely take place outside, so please ensure your child has plenty of warm layers.

All of the children will need a packed lunch on the day (no sweets, drinks flasks, glass bottles or fizzy drinks please). As this will be a busy day, we suggest including an extra snack such as fruit or crisps. If your child is entitled to a free school meal and you would like the school to provide one on the day, please comment 'PACKED LUNCH REQUIRED' in the comments section on the School Gateway.

Payment of voluntary contributions, consent for the trip and request for a school packed lunch can be made through the School Gateway on-line payment system. Details and a link for the gateway are also available on our school website.

This will be a fantastic day that will be sure to inspire and motivate the children.
