Safer Internet Day

Tuesday 5th February is Safer Internet Day, and will be celebrated globally with the slogan 'Together for a better Internet.'

This year in the UK, Safer Internet Day will focus on how consent works in an online context and will ask young people to explore how they ask, give, and receive consent online. This could be in their friendships or relationships, how they take and share images and videos or how they manage their privacy and data.

In Kestrels' class we have already explored what we give permission for when we go online, and we were shocked to learn that when we sign up to any social media platform such as Facebook or Instagram we give permission for them to use any of the photos that we upload in any way that they want.

Please try to take the time to have a conversation with your child about the way they use the Internet and how they ask and give permission for things online. For example, when they are playing a game, talking to their friends or searching for information.
