Week Beginning 7th January

This week will be learning about 'Fantastic Food' and hope to have lots of different kinds of food try from all around the world. **Please remember to bring in a traditional or favourite food your family enjoy this Wednesday 9th January.** We will be talking about our likes and dislikes and beginning to look at where different food comes from. We will be writing lists and finding out about favourite dishes we would like to cook.

Our 'Talk for Writing' story will be 'The Enormous Turnip'. Children will be learning to tell the story with actions using a story map. We will be sending home a story map for you to try this at home.

In maths we will be comparing and measuring different size vegetables. We will be changing the home corner into a fruit and vegetable stall and would welcome any donations of real fruit and vegetables to get us started.

If you would like to support your child further at home, you could:

- Visit a fruit and vegetable shop or super market and look at all the different produce. Look at where they have been grown. Can you find the longest vegetable? The tiniest fruit?
- Try a new fruit or vegetable. How many different ones do you like? Can you list them?
- Cook together- maybe try a dish that is traditional to another country.
- If you have cooking scales use them to weigh different ingredients.
