## Curriculum News

### **Week Beginning 14th January**

This week will be learning about healthy fruit and vegetables. We will be talking about our likes and dislikes and looking at where in the world they come from. We will be looking closely at the different fruit and vegetables, touching, smelling and tasting them. We will be printing and doing observational drawings.

Our 'Talk for Writing' story will continue to be 'The Enormous Turnip'. Children will be learning to tell the story with actions using a story map. We will be sending home a story map for you to try this at home.

In maths we will be non-standard measurement, measuring with different units such as blocks, hands and feet.

If you would like to support your child further at home, you could:

- Visit a fruit and vegetable shop or super market and look at all the different produce. Look at where they have been grown. Can you find the longest vegetable? The tiniest fruit?
- Try a new fruit or vegetable. How many different ones do you like? Can you list them?
- Cook together- maybe try a dish that is traditional to another country.
- If you have cooking scales use them to weigh different ingredients.
