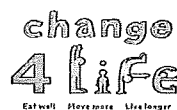
Children are invited to come to school in their own clothes on Friday, 15th February in return for donations for Audrina.

Audrina's Fight Against Neuroblastoma.

I am writing to you on behalf of St. Wystan's School, Repton, to ask if you would consider joining forces with us and Foremarke Hall in an urgent joint fundraising appeal.

You may have seen in the local media articles about a little girl at St Wystan's School (Audrina, age 4, Kindergarten), who has recently been diagnosed with an aggressive form of cancer (Neuroblastoma). She has recently had an operation to remove a tumour from her spine; leading up to this she has endured rounds of chemotherapy, radiotherapy and immunotherapy. She had a stem cell transplant earlier this month, and is currently in isolation, feeling very poorly. Unfortunately, there is a 50% chance that the tumour may return - and if it does, her chances of survival are just one in ten. Her family have recently started a fundraising campaign, because there is a pioneering treatment in America which would massively increase her chances of survival - they need a whopping £200,000 for Audrina to travel to America to receive this treatment. They are hoping that she will be able to go in October '19, when her treatment with the NHS is complete.

As a school, St Wystan's are doing all we can to help Audrina's family to fundraise. We have arranged a non-uniform day on Friday 15th February, and our pupils will be invited to make an optional donation. We are delighted that Foremarke Hall have agreed to join forces with us, and are asking the same of their pupils.

St Wystan's would like to extend an invitation to you – please would you consider joining us in a non-uniform day on Friday 15th February (or another day around this date), to help this little girl who so desperately needs a little help from a lot of people? We are a very small school, as I'm sure you are aware – we are hoping that as many schools as possible will join us in this venture, so that together we can make a real impact.
