Topic:

Our topic this term is

Earthquakes and Volcanoes

We will be learning about the features of volcanoes, their formation and distribution around the globe. We will also learn what an earthquake is, where they occur, why they happen and how they are measured.

Our topic will be incorporated as much as possible into the curriculum including English and Guided Reading. We will also be creating Artwork based on volcanic eruptions and using our topic to choreograph a dance.
