

Additional Resource Provision Curriculum statement

The Additional Resource Provision plans a modified curriculum relating to the National Curriculum. Personalised curriculum plans are created for each child according to their individual special educational need. Precision teaching is the vehicle for providing a programme which reflects their ever-changing needs and interests throughout the year. The skills developed across the ARP incorporate aspects of the EYFS curriculum through to National Curriculum based on dependent on personal needs. The children's learning extends to ensuring importance is given to developing life skills necessary for developing independence in the real world. This ensures the children are able to communicate and form positive social relationships. Wherever possible the children access an age-appropriate curriculum, with the intention of them learning alongside their peers in the mainstream setting. Staff expertise also enables some individual children from the mainstream to receive individualised programmes to support their needs should it be required.
