In maths we will be continuing finding 2 parts that make a whole and exploring lots of different ways of making different numbers. We will be focusing on writing our numbers 0-9 and making sure they are the right way around.

On Tuesday we hope to go for a walk around the local environment and would welcome help from parents and carers to enable us to do this. We will also be visiting the local shops and purchasing chips to enjoy at the playground.
