Curriculum News

In Fir Class this term we are learning;

- **Maths** - During this term we will be covering a range of areas that allow the children to use and develop their problem solving and reasoning skills. The children have access to a range of practical activities and resources to support their learning. We will focus primarily on recognising amounts in small groups and subitising.
- **English** - In Communication, Language and Literacy the children will be focusing on listening to a range of different books including both fiction and non-fiction texts. The children will also continue to use their daily phonic lessons to support them in their reading and writing activities. In their writing, the children will be focusing on learning to hold a sentence, build a sentence and to write their own sentences.
- **Topic**- In topic we are learning about Superheroes and the Animal Kingdom.
- **RE**- The units that we will be looking at this term will be 'Chinese New Year' and 'Easter'. Our focus will be learning about different cultures and celebrations around the world. We will also learn about the Easter story.
- **PE** - Invasion Games

Please read with your child as regularly as possible as this makes a huge difference in all areas of their learning. Please aim to read with your child at least 10 minutes on a daily basis and also remember to record in your child's reading diaries when you have read to ensure that they don't miss out on the reward of a free book once their bookmark is completed.
