## Headline

We are delighted to share with you the findings from our most recent Ofsted Inspection (22.01.19)

As you know, the 'Section 8' inspection was a one day inspection with one Inspector, Julie Sackett, to check that Brompton-Westbrook continues to be a 'Good' school. Julie Sackett carried out a rigorous and robust review of the whole school, which included observing all classes, meeting with pupils, parents and many staff members and looking at the learning environment and pupils' books. In her findings she was very complimentary about the school and decided that she firmly agreed that we continue to be 'Good'!

Attached to the newsletter is the full report – it makes an interesting read and hopefully you will find that it reflects our school really well. Mrs Heyes, The Westbrook Trust's CEO, certainly felt this and commented,
