Dogs on school premises

Following our letter regarding KS2 end of the day routines we would just like to refer back to the comment regarding bringing dogs on to the school premises. The letter dated 23rd January stated:

We understand that many parents bring their dogs when collecting their children. You are still welcome to do so but please ensure your dog is on a lead at all times on the school property and any dog waste is removed immediately. This will be readdressed in future if this guidance is not adhered to.

After seeking external advice, and having no problems with dog foul, we feel we do not need to readdress this issue at this time. Guidance states that owners must take responsibility and use common sense when bringing their dogs on to school premises. Dog foul must be cleared immediately and all dogs must be on a lead.

We would ask that due to the youth and inexperience of pupils in EYFS and KS1 that parents do not bring dogs onto the KS1 playground. This is to keep everyone safe.
