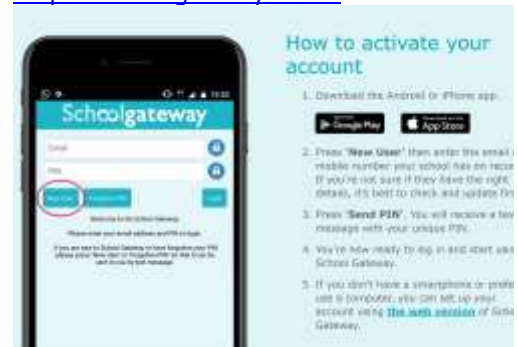

## How to log in

- Once you have your PIN, go ahead and launch the School Gateway app on your smartphone or tablet.
- Enter the email you have registered with your school and the PIN you received. If you didn't get a PIN, it is likely because your school doesn't have the right contact info. Get in touch with them to check.
- If both the email and PIN are entered correctly, hit "Login" and you're ready to start engaging with your school.
