Governor Visits

Each Governor is involved in monitoring and evaluating the School's progress towards achieving the objectives in the annual School Learning Plan. This can involve visiting the school to observe elements of the SLP in action, meeting with staff to discuss their roles and/or checking policy and procedures are in place. This term, Mrs Quirk has visited to review Safeguarding procedures, monitor the spending of the Pupil Premium Grant across the school and shadowed a New Parent Tour. Mrs Adams has visited to observe provision for the More-Able children in Year 2, discuss and observe some of the interventions taking place across the school, discuss allocation of the Sport's Premium Grant and observe our Inclusion TA supporting children in classes. Each Governor completes a Visit Report that is shared with the whole Governing Body and these are then discussed at Committee meetings. The impact of our provision is carefully considered and findings inform how the school proceeds further.
