

Appeal to raise £239,000 for Harry's cancer treatment in New York

by end of April 2019*

Two-year-old Harry is cheeky and full of mischief. He loves all vehicles, especially 'nee-naws' - ones with a siren!

But this gorgeous little boy has been diagnosed with high-risk neuroblastoma, an aggressive childhood cancer which returns almost 50% of the time. If that happens, Harry would have a less than 1 in 10 chance of survival.

So Harry's parents are appealing for your support. They need to access a vaccine in New York that's showing promising signs in reducing the chances of relapse, giving Harry the best chance at living cancer-free.

Funds raised will go towards helping Harry and his family. If Harry no longer needs the funds or is in remission 5 years post the end of successful treatment, the funds will be used to support other children and families affected by neuroblastoma through our activities.



The fundraising target identified above covers the cost of treatment, the associated costs (e.g. travel and accommodation) as well as contingency for any unforeseen complications. For children with high-risk neuroblastoma, like Harry, the survival rate is much lower than other childhood cancers. Upon response, the rate reduces even further to less than one in ten. Harry is nearing the end of immunotherapy treatment and everyone hopes he will be in remission when he has his end of treatment scans in April 2019.
