English

This week, we are going to be carrying using all of our learning about the countries of Great Britain to write a letter back to Miss Bevins and her children in Thailand. We will be asking the children to recall their favourite facts and then write them down focussing on the following objectives:



- © Use phonic knowledge to segment words to spell correctly.
- © Write in full sentences that are demarcated with a capital letter and full stop.
- © Form lower case letters correctly.

We have carried this task out in small groups so that we really get the best writing from all children which has meant it has taken longer than normal to complete. If not working alongside an adult, children have been given challenges to complete independently to continue to develop them as confident writers.

Spelling:

© Towards the end of the week, children will be given the following new tricky words to learn how to spell:

six, seven, eight, nine, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen

Maths
