

Early Years at Woodlesford Primary School- General Information

The following may answer some general queries. If not please do get in touch!

<p>PE</p> <p>We have PE in Reception on Wednesday's. Please make sure your child has their kit for that day (White T shirt, black shorts and black pumps) Long hair needs to be tied back and any earrings covered with tape or removed please. Please name all PE kit!!</p>	<p>Playing Out</p> <p>We do play out in all weathers and would appreciate it if you can name their clothes and send them dressed for the weather that day. Named wellies welcome!</p>
<p>Water bottles</p> <p>If your child brings in a water bottle, please make sure it is named and taken home each day to be refilled. We do have fresh water available in class each day.</p>	<p>Milk</p> <p>Milk is free until the week in which your child has their 5th birthday. After that you have to order and pay for it. Details are on the website or through the school office</p>
<p>Dinners</p> <p>We help your child choose a dinner each day when they start to come into class on their own. Menus are on the website so you can choose together. If your child is vegetarian or has other dietary needs, please let staff know. Dinners can be paid for through the parent pay system.</p>	<p>Lost property</p> <p>We keep un-named lost property in Reception/Nursery for a couple of days and then move it to the school lost property section under Nursery. If it is named we will of course return it to its owner!</p>
<p>Class bears</p> <p>Reception award the class bear on a Friday to go home for the weekend with a child who has had a great week in school! There is a diary for you to complete about his adventures but please don't stress about adding pictures if this is a problem and do let your child add a note if they would like to! They like to come back to school on a Monday!</p>	<p>Observations</p> <p>We keep observations of your child at play in class via the iPad and these will be sent home to you at the end of a term. You can add to them at home via the 2simple app. We also keep a scrapbook of any notable pieces of work and if you have anything you would like to add to it please do send it in, so we can see what they are up to at home!</p>

Celebration Assemblies

On Fridays Reception can join the older children for a celebration assembly. If your child has received an award or certificate and they would like to bring it in on a Friday please do send it in and ask them to tell us they have it. If you can make sure that their name is on it too, we will ensure it is returned!

Reading Days

In Reception we listen to your child read their scheme book and replace it each week. Please can you make sure their book bag and all its' contents are in school each day?

If you listen to your child read, do please add a comment or initial their Reading Record book, so we know you have shared it with them. Do log on to Bug Club if you would like to access extra books online.

Key Workers

Your child has a Key worker who makes sure they are settled at school. Of course any adult in class will support them if the Key worker is not in school. If you would like to discuss any issue with them, please do not hesitate to get in touch.

Interests

We are very keen to hear what your child is interested in at home. We send home sheets each half term (or paper leaves in Nursery) for you to complete with your child to tell us. Please return them and it will help staff and key workers plan for your children in class.
