Greggs Breakfast Club

A Reminder that, our Greggs Breakfast Club is still running daily in our school hall from **8.25am - 8.55am**. This is a free Breakfast Club for **40 children**.

Places need to be booked on Parent Pay each **Wednesday for the following week. You can only sign up for a week at a time****

For example - Places for Week commencing 25th February 2019 will be released on Wednesday 20th February 2019.

Our **Grab and Go Breakfast club** is also still running from the bottom door in the yard but is now at the new time of **8.40am - 8.50am**. Toast will be available and is free of charge.

School Meal/ Breakfast and After School Club Payments

May we remind our parents that it is school policy that all school meals, Breakfast and After School clubs are paid for on Parent Pay a week in advance.

For example - if you are wanting your child to have school meals for the week then a payment of £11.50 needs to be paid on the Monday of that week. School meals cost **£2.30 per day** so if you know that your child will be having one please make sure that this is paid on Parent Pay the evening before.

Breakfast Club places are **£3.50 per day** and **After School Club** is **£6.50 per day**.

Could we please ask that parents check their Parent Pay accounts and make sure all payments are up to date.

Whitehough Trip - Year 6

If your child is attending the Year 6 Whitehough Trip the next instalment of £25.00 is due to be paid no later than **Friday 15th March**.

School Start Time

Please could we remind parents that school starts at **8.55am**. All children should be in their class lines, ready to go into school by no later than **8.55am**.
