Informing the children of who to speak to in school if they are unhappy, each classroom has a worry box and we are adapting our curriculum to meet the needs of our children to excite and enthuse them.

We have trained staff in all current educational practices to assess and adapt leaning on a daily basis to accelerate progress across school.

The school has a comprehensive teaching and learning monitoring program to support all the staff. The school improves teaching through research based training.
