SEND offer

EYFS arrangements

- Currently 30 children in the morning and 30 children in the afternoon for the first 5 days (1.5 hours in school)
- Then all 60 children in for the morning and lunch for 2-3 days.
- Then full time.

School Development Plan

- What we have said:
 - Produce a skills based progression document for Foundation Subjects which is manageable and clearly defines what skills children will develop across subjects each year.
 - Purchase a Science scheme of work.
 - Improve differentiation for children with SEND in lessons. (This could include peer to peer support)
 - Review the school's Rewards and Behaviour Policy.
 - Use parent forum to identify what information parents would like about pupil progress.
 - Employ a dedicated pastoral care worker across the school.
 - Increase the number of hours that the SENCo works.
 - Review of the Anti-Bullying Policy.
 - Maintain attendance rates to be above 97%.
 - Continue to develop practices to enable children to stay safe online.
 - Improve playtimes and lunchtimes through training of staff and more equipment.
