

English

In the Spring Term we will be using the story of 'The Stone Age Boy' to develop our narrative writing skills. Also, we will be using our Stone Age themed trip to inform our own explanation text on how to survive the Stone Age.

Computing

We will be using a software program called Scratch to program and create our own games, stories and animations.

Maths

During the term, we will be looking at the units: further multiplication and division, fractions, decimals, statistics and time. There will still be a heavy emphasis on the recall of number facts and mental methods of calculation in this term.

History

We will be studying the Stone Age and Iron Age within Britain. To bring this to life we are going on a Stone Age themed trip. We will also look at how people lived, what they believed in and what their art shows us. We will also cover their beliefs as well as tribal territories.

Spanish

In this unit the focus is on naming animals, family members and pets. They will be introduced to verbs and how they are used.

Science

Our Science units this term will explore living things and their habitats as well as variety of everyday materials and what happens when they are heated or cooled.

PE

This term we will be focusing on fundamental movement skills specifically looking at floor movement skills and dynamic balance to agility.

RE

The unit is called religion and the individual. Children will explore aspects of Christianity and Islam and to discover what is expected of a person who follows a religion.

Art

Linking to our topic of the Stone Age we will be researching and creating cave art. They will create cave drawings and paintings, using ideas and things that represent that time.

This term children will continue to play brass instruments and will develop their cornet skills further and start to learn musical notes in sequence.
