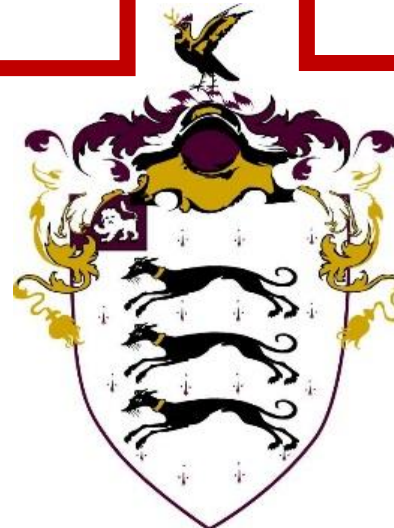
Boosters will continue on Friday morning at 8am with myself, Mr Wilkinson and Mrs Carpenter

## RE
