



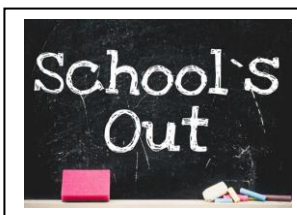
Weekly Update – 15th February 2019

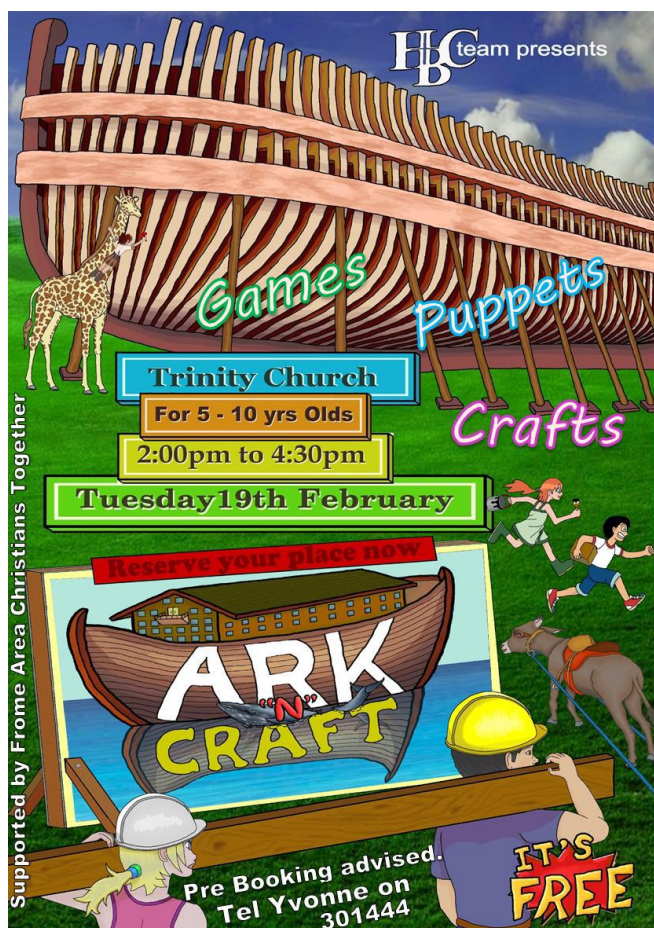
