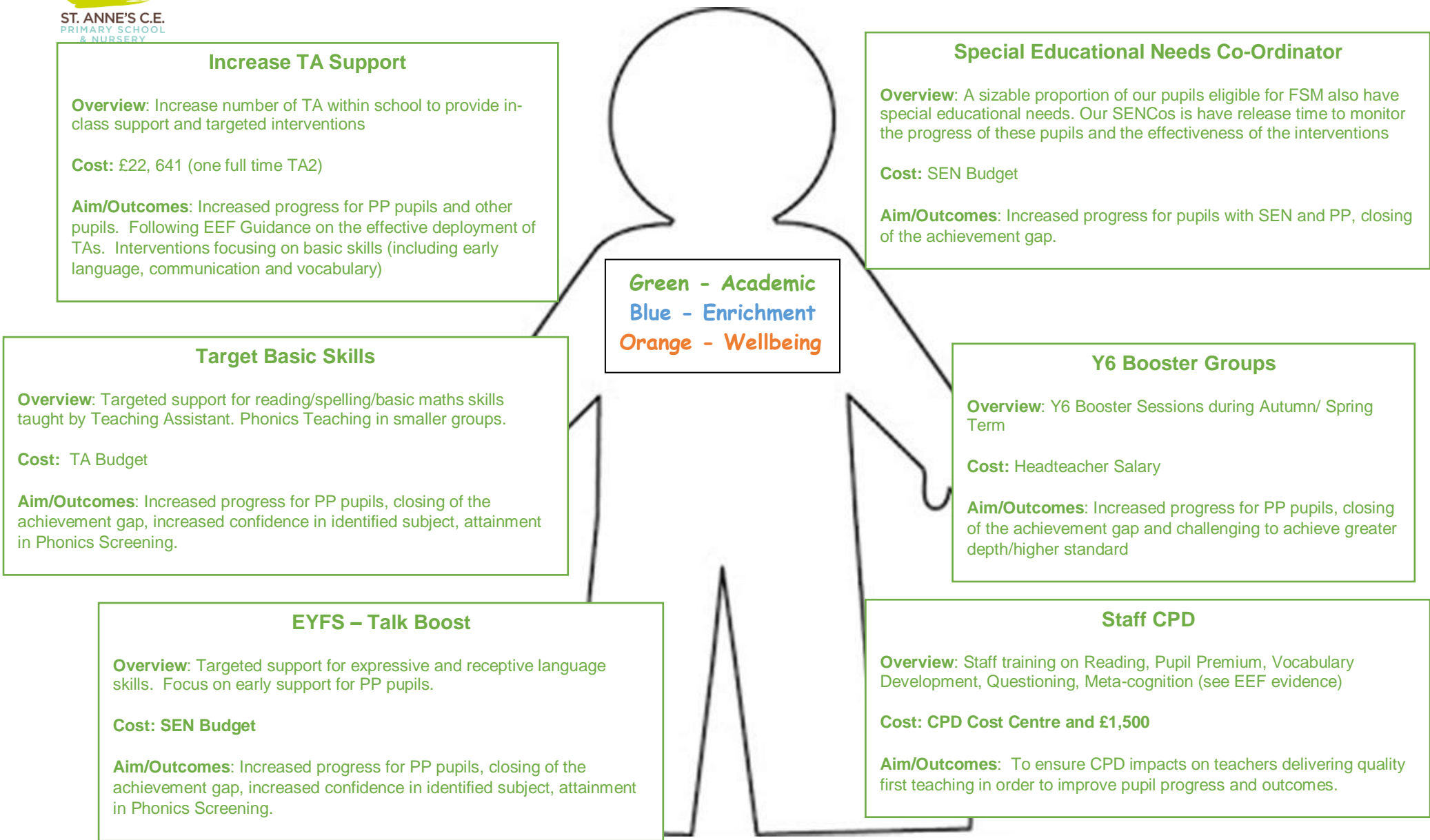




# Pupil Premium Provision Map 2018 - 2019

£34,960 (£34,945)

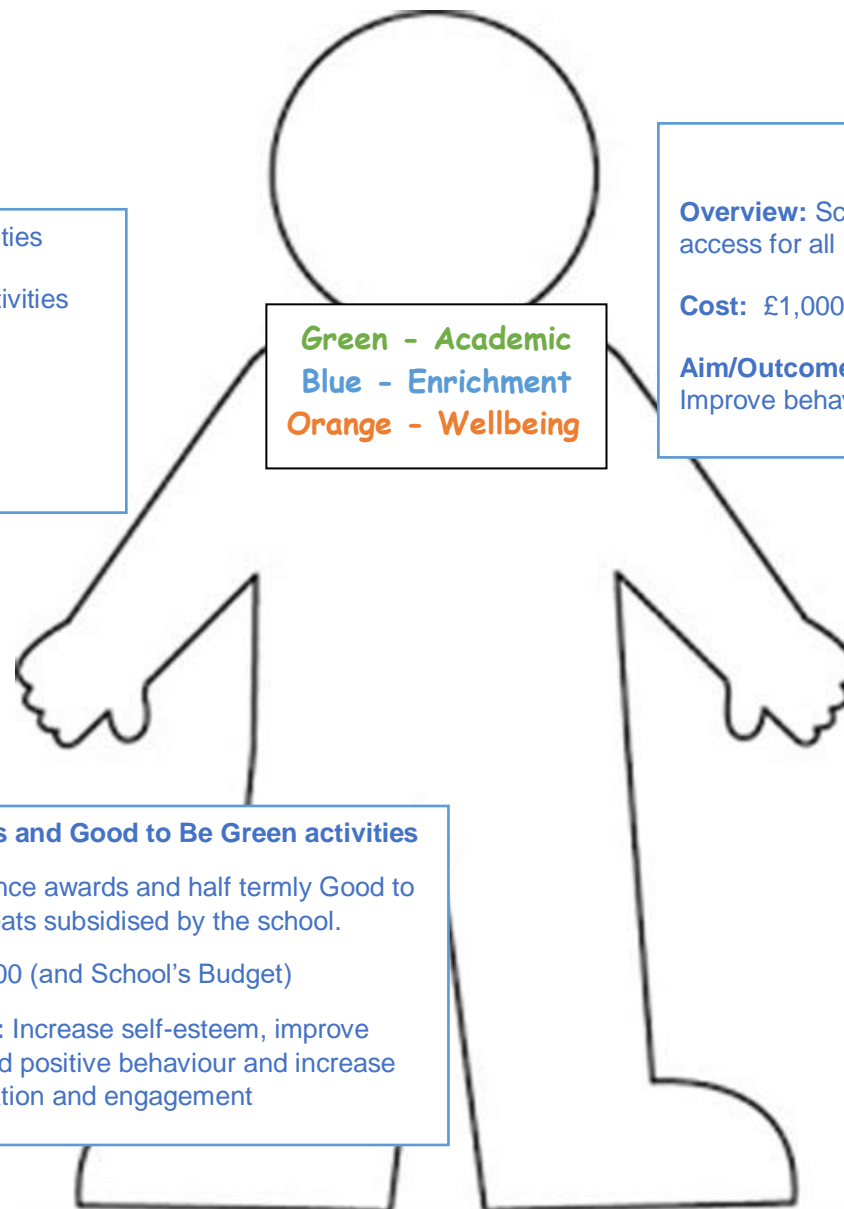

## Subsidised Trips

**Overview:** School trips and residential subsidised to ensure access for all pupils

**Cost:** £1,000

**Aim/Outcomes:** Raise aspiration, motivation and engagement. Improve behaviour. Give a purpose/meaning to learning

## Extra-Curricula Activities / Lunchtime Activities

**Overview:** Target children for extra-curricula activities

**Cost:** PE & Sports Grant

**Aim/Outcomes:** Provide extended curriculum opportunities and improve pupils access to PE

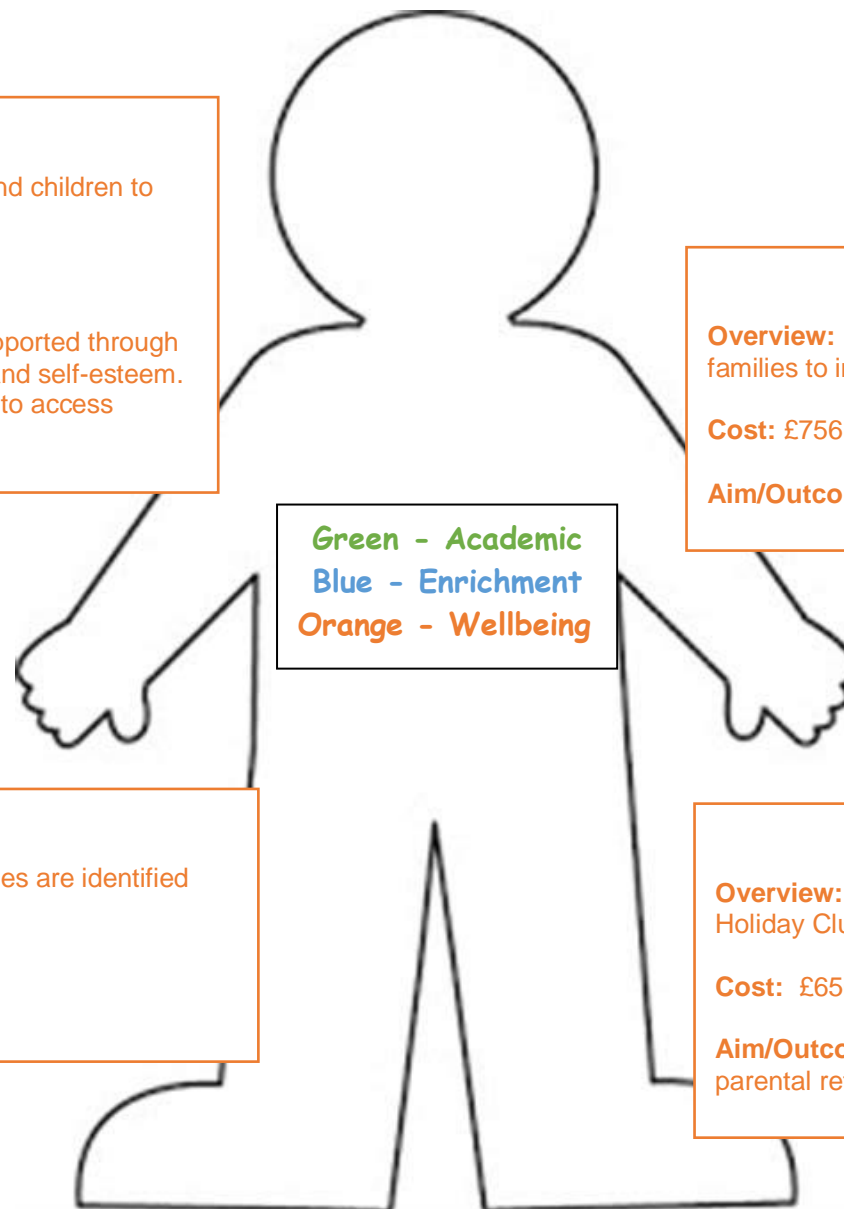
## Attendance awards and Good to Be Green activities

**Overview:** Attendance awards and half termly Good to Be Green Treats subsidised by the school.

**Cost:** £500 (and School's Budget)

**Aim/outcomes:** Increase self-esteem, improve attendance, reward positive behaviour and increase aspiration and engagement

## Emotional Wellbeing Support

**Overview:** Our SEMH TA2 works with families and children to provide pastoral care

**Cost:** £7,548

**Aim/Outcomes:** Pupils with additional needs supported through a variety of interventions. Increased confidence and self-esteem. Pupils happier at school and at home, more able to access learning.

## Education Welfare Officer

**Overview:** EWO, Head, Office Staff work with children and families to improve attendance and punctuality

**Cost:** £756

**Aim/Outcomes:** Improved attendance and punctuality
