We will continue to have free access to one handed tools such as painting, scissors, a wide range of mark making tools. We will take part in regular cooking activities




Knowledge and Understanding

We will be using our imagination to develop storylines to discover and explore new worlds and far away lands. We will think about what we will do when we get there, what we need to pack, and how we are going to get there


We will continue to sing everyday and have focus songs each week
