WEEKLY	Reading (At least three times a week). Spellings (Practise your spellings for your test). Complete the weekly home learning task set by Miss Moseley.	
TERMLY	<u>Musical sounds!</u> Using whatever craft materials you have at home, make your own musical instrument. This can be a known musical instrument or you could design and make your own musical instrument. Please bring your work into school. Have fun!	<u>Sound check</u> Choose somewhere at home (inside or outside) to sit and listen to the sounds you can hear. It sometimes helps to close your eyes, so you can really focus. Make a note of all the sounds you can hear, from the loudest to the quietest and then display these on a poster. You could draw yourself in the middle of the paper, then draw the sounds around the edge and then describe the sounds, e.g. wood on the fire burns quietly.
	<u>Taste test!</u> As part of our topic, 'Food, Glorious Food', carry out a fruit and/or vegetable taste test with an adult. Who can correctly identify the different foods?	<u>Mathletics</u> This is a fun online maths resource that the school has made available to you. Play games, solve puzzles and challenge yourself and your friends. Your login details will be inside your home learning books. Please include your score, the date and maths subject in your home learning book.
