Year Group: 6 Topic: Enterprise

English

- Our focus in English this term will be narrative writing.
- Our first piece of writing will be a mystery story based upon the short film titled 'Alma'. We will consider which structural and language features to use in order to create suspense-filled fiction.
- Our SPAG lessons will continue to focus on gaps from our practice SATs papers in the final run-up to SATs.
- We will also have extra reading sessions to continue to practise our reading paper skills.
- **Reading booster will continue on Tuesdays after school.**

Science

- During this half term, our topic is Animals, including Humans, wherein we will focus on our bodies. We will learn about the functions of different organs, with a particular focus on the heart and circulatory system.

PE

- PE will be taught on a Monday afternoon by sports coaches. This unit will be field games.

History, Geography, Art, Music, French, D&T, and ICT

- In Design and Technology, we will be working on our enterprise skills. We will be challenged to create our own businesses to plan, design, make advertise and sell products.
- Our Art this term will be linked to our topic of Enterprise. We will create posters and advertising to promote our products, as well as company logos.
- We will also be using some of our afternoon sessions this term to focus on revision for Reading, Maths and SPAG, ready for our SATs next half term.
- After SATs, we will also have our termly Music day and will have visits from students from QKA to support us in our learning of MFL.
