




Cathedral

English

The children will be exploring the book "There is no dragon in this story." They will also be looking at traditional tales, fairy stories and retelling them considering their characteristics. The children will be encouraged to recognise and join in with predictable phrases. In their writing, we will be looking closely at common exception words and using prefixes and suffixes. We will ask the children to use adjectives and verbs in their sentences and to edit and read aloud their work.

Maths

The children will continue to explore addition and subtraction. They will solve problems using concrete objects and pictorial representations, and missing number problems such as 7- ?-9. They will look closely at place value and explore numbers from 0 to 100. Through Art, we will be exploring 2D and 3D shapes.

Science

Through our topic work, we will be looking closely at what makes the perfect house for the three little pigs to live in. The children will identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass and rock. The children will be joining in and participating in different activities during Science Week!



French

This term in French, we will build on our known vocabulary -greetings, colours, numbers, transport, likes, and dislikes- and learn some of the common food. We will also learn a new song! A bientôt!



Computing

Through apps on the iPad, the children will look at creating and debugging simple programs. They will understand what algorithms are; how they are implemented as programmes and how to follow precise instructions.

Design technology

The children will use their science investigations to create and build their own miniature house. They will develop, model and communicate their ideas. They will select from and use a range of tools and equipment. The children will then evaluate their structure to see if it can be 'blown down by the big bad wolf' and what they could do next time to make it stronger. Through art, the children will explore features of a dragon and will be looking closely at the dragon's eyes and scales.

Music

The children will work to use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes. Listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high quality live and recorded music. They will play tuned and un-tuned instruments.

PE

This term in PE, we are going to be visiting the train station and the circus to work on how we balance when we are moving or have a small base of support. We are also going to be thinking about how we recognise similarities and differences in the way ourselves and others are moving.
