

## ENGLISH

### WRITING

Using the Talk for Writing approach the children will be completing some persuasive writing-

They will be learning how to use persuasive writing to write an advert for their very own robot.

They will also be learning how to compose a persuasive letter, trying to persuade the recipient around to their point of view.

### READING

In our reading sessions the children will be focusing on the skills of inference and prediction. They will also be encouraged to summarise the text they have read in 3-5 sentences.

### SPELLINGS

## PE

This half term we will be linking our PE with our topic looking at choreographing our own robot dances, focusing on dynamics of movements. In outdoor PE we will be focusing on improving our ball handling skills both throwing and kicking.

## Destination Space

### SCIENCE Sun and light

Children will learn about the sun; about how it provides light so that we can see, at night it is dark as there is no light, light from the sun is dangerous and we need to protect our eyes

They will look at the patterns of shadows throughout the day - collect evidence and present it in a bar chart.

### ART/ DT

In DT they will be looking at space technology and design their own robot. Children will also write an instruction to explain their design.



### ICT

Children will create a stop and go animation using their previous knowledge of programming and learning about the editing process.



## FRENCH

In French we will be looking at names of body parts, months of the year and learning animal names.

### RE


We will be looking at Christianity and the similarities between stories from the bible featur-

## MATHS

In Maths the children will be looking at improving their knowledge of money. They will be learning about how to add and subtract coins.

Later in the half term they will move on to looking at statistics. Building on their knowledge of bar graphs, pictograms and tables.

Finally they will be looking at the perimeter of regular shapes. Building on this knowledge and applying it to word problems which they could encounter in the wider world.



## GEOGRAPHY

In Geography, the children will use a range of maps to locate the countries.

These will include: world maps, country map, satellite, elevation etc.

We will also look at how planets are mapped.
