Do you feel safe at school? If no, why don't you feel safe?	Yes - 30
Do you feel safe and comfortable in your classroom?	Yes - 30
Who looks after you if you feel ill?	Mrs Tahir, teachers, mum and dad, friends
What would you do if someone made you feel unhappy in school?	Tell an adult in school, befrienders and teachers.
What happens when the fire alarm goes off?	Stop what you are doing, line up, go outside, go to the nearest exit, calmly leave the building and line up, go outside and form a line, wait for an adult to say it is safe to go back in, go outside quietly, walk outside carefully, your teacher counts you, instead of going back to the classroom go to the nearest exit, the teacher will count you in case someone is still inside.
Who makes sure that you are safe at break time?	Teachers on duty, teachers outside, teachers on duty or an adult, the adults in school, support act (think they mean staff).
Who makes sure that you feel safe at lunch time?	Lunchtime staff, lunchtime supervisors.
Who can you talk to in school if you are worried about something?	Somebody you trust, befrienders, any teachers, adult, Mrs Leadbeater, Mr Booth, Mrs Illingworth and any teacher, a friend, trusted adult
If an unknown person came up to you on your way to or from school or	Go to someone you trust or go somewhere safe, tell an adult, go back home or school to find a trusted adult, runaway and tell, run to tell someone you know, run away, run or walk away and tell a teacher, walk away, say 'NO!', run to a safe place, walk away and tell an adult you trust, ignore them.

If an unknown person online tried to persuade you to do something, what would you do?	Tell an adult, block them, delete the message, report it, tell mum and dad, ignore them, tell someone, go off that website, tell a teacher.
Are there any places around school where you take extra care?	Dry stone wall, road, forest, school, pond, climbing frame, school gate, the bee hive, woodland area, school gate, the field,
Do you feel worried about your move to the next class? Middle School (Yr5)	No – 25 Yes - 5
