

SAMPLE MENUS

The Breakfast Club offers a selection of cereals - followed by toast with jam or marmite. Drinks on offer include orange juice, milk, squash or water. The After-School Club aims to provide a nutritious snack that works on a monthly rotation.

- ✓ **Day 1:** Pasta with Bolognese sauce served with ham, cheese, salad
- ✓ **Day 2:** French bread with a choice of fillings and salad
- ✓ **Day 3:** Pitta bread (baked) with coleslaw, ham, cheese, tuna, salad, mayonnaise
- ✓ **Day 4:** Beans on toast
- ✓ **Day 5:** Pasta with cheese and mushroom sauce served with ham, cheese, salad

All meals are served with fruit juice, water or milk, fruit of the day and yoghurts. It is recommended that children attending the after school club have school meals at lunchtime as they will only be having a snack at teatime.

PAYMENT OF FEES

The Smarty Club request payment half termly, in advance. There will be no refunds for non-attendance. A £10 fine will be applied to all late payments.

Parents are required to commit to each term and one month's notice in writing is required when cancelling your child's place.

CLUB TIMES AND CHARGES AS OF 01.09.2018

The Breakfast Club:

7.45- 8.30am Monday to Friday during term time
Cost £6.00 per day £30.00 per week

The After-School Club:

3.15- 6.00pm Monday to Friday during term time
Cost £6.00 HALF SESSION (Collection up to 4.30pm) - £30.00 per week
£14.00 per day FULL SESSION (Collection up to 6.00pm) - £70.00 per week

Late Collection:

If a child is not collected by 6.00pm, carers will incur a charge of £10 per half-hour. These costs are based on staff salaries.

ADMISSIONS POLICY

Membership of the club is open to children aged 4-11 years. Admission to the club is on a first come/first served basis. In the event of the club being oversubscribed, on completion of a registration form, places will be offered on the following basis:

- *Children who are classed as 'looked after' will have priority for admissions.*
- *No priority will be given for children who have a sibling already attending the club.*
- *There will be a waiting list for each day of the week. This is because the number of days children are waiting for varies. It is impossible to have just one waiting list.*
- *Those who want a full time place have a choice of either remaining on the waiting list for each day and accepting the places as they become available, or waiting for a full time place.*
- *When a full time child leaves the club, their place will be offered in the first instance to those on the full time place waiting list. If a day is offered and the parent chooses to decline, they will remain in their place on the waiting list but the place will then be offered to a person below them.*
- *If a parent declines an offer for the third time, they will then move to the bottom of that list.*
- *Pupils attending St Mary's Catholic Primary school*

AIMS OF THE CLUB

1. To provide a safe and secure out of school childcare environment for the children.
2. To provide children with high quality opportunities for play and relaxation, which support individual learning.
3. To provide a nutritionally balanced breakfast and afternoon snack.
4. To ensure staff are able to meet the needs of young children through their qualifications and experience, whilst meeting the requirements of the Children's Act.
5. To provide the correct resources to enhance the child's play and learning opportunities. Creating opportunities for freely chosen play.
6. To offer places to all children regardless of ability, race, gender or disability.

THE BREAKFAST CLUB

7.45-8.15: Breakfast is served

8.15-8.30: Choose from a selection of activities e.g. drawing, charades, connect 4 or finish homework



THE AFTER-SCHOOL CLUB

The Smarty Club has a varied programme of learning and fun activities. Each afternoon there will be focused activities running throughout the session and these will include football, baking, arts and crafts and many more (please see the termly timetable of workshops).

The children will also have access to 'free choice' activities e.g. construction toys, story books/tapes and imaginative play resources.

CHANGES TO COLLECTION FROM THE AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

Starting from Monday 16th April, children will be dismissed from the hall to you, in the entrance lobby. To ensure club security is as safe as possible, only adults who work at The After-School Club will be permitted to enter the hall or the playground. This means that parents will not be allowed to enter the hall and must wait in the entrance lobby for their child to be brought over.

As before, parents/ carers will then be asked to sign their child out.
