This half term's topic is
Where do I live?



Whole School Focus- To develop a lifelong love of learning

English-

Four times a week the children will be following the Read Write Inc. Phonics based program. Each lesson has a basic structure

- **Speed Sounds.** Children are introduced to new sounds, read and spell them in words and recap previously taught sounds
- **Reading** Children read and work on an appropriate level book. This includes recognising and reading words with specific sounds, predicting, understanding and discussing the text.
- **Writing** Children complete daily writing activities to improve the grammar, spelling and content of their written work.

OR

Those children who have completed the Read Write Inc program will begin a standard English lesson which will be based on a whole class book or poem.

Science

We will be starting our new topic of 'Animals including humans.'

The children will learn about basic human and animal needs, how to stay healthy and the different food groups. We will also be looking at the different stages in human and animal growth.

Mathematics – As mathematicians we will focus on

- Weight and Mass
- Temperature
- Solving word problems
- Picture Graphs

RE

This half term our R.E will be leading us up to the key Christian festival of Easter. We will be finding out;

Why does Easter matter?

What is the good news that Jesus brings?

Music

We will be listening to Vivaldi's Four Seasons and learning about to identify different instruments and talk about how music makes us feel. We will be starting to compose short pieces of music with instruments.

Topic This term our topic is 'Where do I live?'

Geography- As a class we will be finding out where the seven continents of the world are and how their proximity to the equator or the poles affects their climate. We will be looking at different countries and exploring their climate and land features. We will be undertaking a variety of fun activities to help them learn more about each one.

Art -

We will be using paint and wax crayons to create paintings based on our responses to Vivaldi's Four Seasons.

Reading

The most important thing that you can do to help your child is read. Please hear them read at least three times a week, read to them every day and record their reading in their diary. There is a very useful section at the back of the reading diaries that provides more information on how best to help your child.

Spellings

Every week the children will have between 3 and 5 of the common exemption words for Year 2 to learn over a week. They will then be tested on a Tuesday morning. The children will then be expected to use those words in all their writing, spelling those words correctly.

Homework

Homework will continue on a weekly basis. Every Wednesday a new piece of work will be stuck into the children's homework books to be completed. Homework is collected in on a Monday.
