SWIMMING LESSONS – Terms 5 and 6

All of Year 4 will be taking part in swimming lessons at Harwell School after Easter. The first lesson is on Thursday 25th April and the last lesson is on 11 July (a total of 10 sessions). No swimming on 23rd May (Yr 4 at Hill End)

Swimming lessons will take place on Thursday mornings and will cater for all abilities of swimmer. Lessons last for about 30 minutes. The children will be swimming in groups of 15 at a time and Class 10 will leave school at 9.15 am; Class 11 will leave school at 10.15 am. Lunches will be as normal.

To take part, children will need:

- One-piece swimming costume, swimming trunks or swimming shorts (preferably with a net inside).
- Towel
- Swimming hat
- Earrings must be removed before swimming.

If your child does not have a hat and/or removed earrings they will not be allowed to swim.

If your child needs to wear goggles while swimming, we will need you to sign and return the slip below giving your permission. Could you please also ensure your child has had breakfast that morning.

Children will have the opportunity to eat their morning snack (if provided) once they have finished swimming.

We ask for a voluntary contribution of £19.16 to help cover the cost of transport. School will be paying for the pool hire and swimming instructor. Please pay for this via ParentPay.
