The event will begin at 3:45pm and there is a cost of £1 per child for this event which must be paid to the school office in a sealed and labelled envelope. As this event takes place close to the end of the school day, you will need to collect your child from the office at 2:50pm. If your child has siblings at the school and you can not organise collection for these, they may also be collected at 2:45pm from the office. **Please inform your child's teacher and the school office if this is the case.**

This is an outdoor competition and may be subject to adverse weather, it is therefore important that the children are suitably dressed with appropriate outdoor trainers, track suit/ shorts. They will also need a bottle of water and a small snack. If your child is new to the cross country league, I will provide them with a running number which they can use at every race until they leave Oakworth Primary. Children who have run before, please make sure you wear your regular number and **please bring safety pins** to attach your running number.

I will be attending the event, however please be aware that: **Parents must take, bring back and be in charge of their child at the event due to the large number of children attending.**

Any parents and friends who are able to join us for the event are, of course most welcome, as it is very encouraging for the children to have supporters to cheer them on. We do however insist that only positive comments are made throughout the competition to both competitors and officials.
