I am very pleased to share with you the arrangements for our second Golden Time Afternoon of the year, taking place this Friday (1st March). This new arrangement for Golden Time has given us an opportunity to pursue new and exciting opportunities (listed below) for the children we can spread out over the year. The staff and I believe that pupils grow in confidence and have more to write about when they are given new experiences.

Please note that pupils in Class 1 are already welcoming visitors from the Oriental Museum on this day.

ACTIVITIES	DETAILS
Walking and map skills at Castle Eden (6 pupils from the Juniors)	Pupils will be driven in staff cars. They will leave school before lunch and return before the end of the school day. They will require a packed lunch. <u>Pupils will also require warm, outdoor clothing, a coat and solid trainers or walking shoes. These can be worn throughout the day.</u>
Bowling (26 pupils from the Juniors)	Pupils will have a normal lunch and be transported to bowling by coach. They will return before the end of the school day. <u>Pupils do not need anything for this activity.</u>
Cookery (8 pupils from the Juniors)	Pupils will remain in school to produce cakes and biscuits. This is the 'practice' before a special event for Red Nose Day. <u>Pupils do not need anything for this activity.</u>
Leadership skills (helping the Infants) (5 pupils from the Juniors)	Pupils will help Mrs. Peacock and the sports coach during the Infants' afternoon of sports and crafts. They will be encouraged to lead groups. <u>Pupils will require a PE kit for this activity.</u>
Sports activities with Simon Carson Sports School followed by Arts and Crafts (Infants pupils)	Pupils will take part in sports and crafts activities <u>Pupils will require a PE kit for this activity.</u>

We are offering all activities for free. However, we would welcome contributions of £2 from everyone who feels able to help us cover the costs associated with transport, bowling, cooking ingredients, sports coach etc. We are already planning future activities including a technology visit, a football tournament, skiing. The School Council would also love to hear of any other suggestions.
