

Review of Sporting Premium Grant 2017-2018
Allocation £18500

Priority 1 totally changed. Sports Court project shelved and a 'Mile a Day' track put in. The cost was £13,000 money put in from school budget. From Y6 across to FS1 the whole school uses the track regularly increasing sporting participation dramatically. The children have regular access to sporting facilities. Minimum the track is used by classes twice a week and all children are involved.

Priority 2 not completed as the money, £5000, was allocated to the 'Mile a Day' track.

Priority 3 Training for named staff has been accessed to the cost of £1500. Training has involved sports coaches.

Priority 4 Transport, full budget of £2000 used. Our children have continued to participate in a large number of sporting festivals and competitions which they thoroughly enjoyed. The children continue to enjoy 2 hours of PE a week and over 20 of pupils participate in extracurricular sporting and physical activities on a weekly basis. The school was also awarded the Gold Games Mark for 2018. Our school also enjoyed significant sporting success during the year in a number of sporting disciplines.
