School have been made aware of something called 'Momo'. The character prompts children to hurt themselves or others by doing unsafe acts, usually by "popping up" during YouTube streaming.

We would ask that all parents:

- Ensure that you know what your children can access online;
- Ensure that children understand the importance of not giving personal information to anyone that they do not know;
- Tell your children that nobody has the right to make them do anything that they do not want to do;
- Use parental controls to keep your children safe online.
